# KROME SHINES AT RADIO

"Turn It Up," the new single from Vancouver quartet Krome, moves 49-46 in its second week on the Canada Rock chart.

The band is the brainchild of vocalist/guitarist Shawn Meehan, who formed the band in 2004. The

lineup now includes guitarist Randy Robertson, bassist Adam Reid and drummer Scott Aquino. They quickly became veterans of the road, crossing the country to promote their first independent album, "Neglected," which went on to sell 3,000 copies, according to Nielsen SoundScan.

In late 2005, they signed a deal with Shoreline, distributed by Universal Music Canada, and released their self-titled album in the spring of 2006. After receiving grants through Videofact, the video station MuchLoud became a supporter of the band,

putting the videos for "Human Zoo," "Lost in Travel" and "Until the End" in rotation.

In June 2009, the band announced the signing of a new management deal with Dexter Entertainment on its MySpace page. The act is finishing work on a new EP that will be released by the end of September through Dexter/604/Universal Music Canada, followed by a full-length album early next year. The group has also just signed a deal for agency representation through Feldman and Associates and will soon embark on a 23-city cross-country tour.
